## Historic Jump from the Junkers Ju-52



### Achtung !

Follow in the footsteps of the German Paratroopers of World War 2 and join us on a historic jump from a Junkers Ju-52 aircraft. This operation will be part of an international paratrooper reunion and air show, which will take place at the birthplace of German Airborne Forces, in Stendal, Germany.

**25-30 August 2010**

#### **This operation will include:**

- = Two overnight stays in Berlin, Germany;
- = Ground transport from Berlin to Stendal and return;
- = Hotel accommodations in Stendal;
- = Air Show entrance and registration fees;
- = Basic Airborne Refresher training;
- = One familiarization jump from a French MH-1521 "Broussard" or Russian AN-2 "Colt;"
- = One jump from the Junkers Ju-52;
- = International Paratrooper Party and social evening.



**Additional jumps from the Ju-52, or other aircraft, are available and may be purchased on site.**
